It is difficult to have a home one day, only to be asked to leave that home the next. This is what happened to "Michael" prior to coming to Lazarus House. He struggled with depression, which caused many challenges in his life. Within the Emergency Shelter, his case manager assisted him in getting connected with mental health services in the area. He also began working with the Employment Coordinator at Lazarus House to find steadier employment, which he was able to do through a part-time job. In addition, he was connected with services through Renz Center in Elgin for support with substance abuse issues. His hard work and perseverance was helping him gain stability and confidence.



"Michael" then applied for the Center for Transitional Living and moved into that program shortly thereafter. Here he worked with his case manager weekly to move forward toward goals that would help him gain independence. This included paying off debts, maintaining reliable transportation, and identifying housing opportunities. He moved forward steadily and with his case manager, continued to look into housing options. Reaching out to our partner, Ecker Center for Mental Health, to see what programs they had was a natural choice, as "Michael" was already receiving services there. The program that best suited him had a waiting list and he was told that it may be a while. However, within a few weeks their Supported Apartment program had an unanticipated opening and "Michael" went for an interview, was accepted and moved within SEVEN days. It is great to see the stability that he has gained through his connections with services here at Lazarus House and within the community. We wish him all the best.

I wanted to start out by thanking our community for making our capital campaign such a success. We are continually humbled by the support our community provides Lazarus House. We had a goal of reaching \$1,700,000 which would allow us to help pay down the mortgage on the 214 Walnut Street building as well as complete some very necessary renovations to place all of our programs under one roof. With the work of our amazing capital campaign team, especially our co-chairs John Mason and J.C. Gonzalez-Mendez and our absolutely fabulous community, we raised \$1,826,911 or 107% of our goal! We are truly blessed to be able to continue our mission of building hope and providing our homeless population with food, safe shelter and tools for life.


